The validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Brighton, Monroe County, New York is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Brighton on March 9, 2017.

1. The resolution is entitled “BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$23,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO FINANCE THE COST OF ACQUIRING AND CONSTRUCTING THE IMPROVEMENTS CONSTITUTING THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON SUSQUEHANNA ROAD & NORTHUMBERLAND ROAD DRAINAGE DISTRICT”.

2. The specific object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized is to finance the estimated cost of acquiring, constructing and equipping the improvements to be included in the Town of Brighton Susquehanna Road & Northumberland Road Drainage District, including the acquisition of land and/or easements or other rights therein, and the construction of improvements consisting of sewer mains, lateral lines, interconnection appurtenances, road borings, manholes, force mains, valves, pumps, curb stops, original furnishings, equipment, machinery or apparatus, fill, services, including, without limitation, the installation of approximately 430 feet of 12-inch HDPE storm sewer, along with six (6) storm inlets, connecting to the existing storm sewer along Brooklawn Drive in the Town, and all other appurtenant and incidental improvements necessary or appropriate to serve benefited properties within said sewer district, all engineering and other preliminary costs, legal expenses and other costs incidental to the financing thereof.

3. The period of probable usefulness is 40 years.

4. The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$23,000.

The resolution summarized herein shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours at the offices of the Town Clerk of the Town of Brighton, located 2300 Elmwood Avenue, Rochester, New York 14618.
