The resolution, a summary of which is published herewith, has been adopted on August 9, 2017 by the Town Board of the Town of Brighton, Monroe County, New York (the “Town”), and the validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town is not authorized to expend money or if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of publication of this notice, or such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.

### SUMMARY OF BOND RESOLUTION

Set forth below is a summary of said resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Brighton, Monroe County, New York (the “Town”) on August 9, 2017.

1. The resolution is entitled “BOND RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON, MONROE COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE “TOWN”), AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF UP TO \$350,000 IN SERIAL BONDS OF THE TOWN TO UNDERTAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE TOWN OF BRIGHTON CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT”.

2. The object or purpose for which the bonds are authorized: improvements to the Town of Brighton Consolidated Sewer District (the “District”) consisting of the rehabilitation of the existing Blossom Road sanitary collection system consisting of the installation of one eight-foot diameter dog-house and four five-foot diameter dog-house manholes over the existing 18-inch sanitary sewer, the installation of approximately 47 linear feet of 18-inch sanitary sewers and approximately 20 linear feet of 16-inch sanitary sewers to connect the manholes, and the installation of a new plug valve, including site-work improvements and all ancillary and related work required in connection therewith.

3. The period of probable usefulness is forty (40) years.

4. The amount of obligations authorized to be issued is \$350,000.
